### Inclusive:

### Intentional:

- Who is the accused in this section? The prosecutor? The witnesses? The judge and jury?
- Under cross-examination what does the accused have to say? What does the silence imply? Is the accused guilty as charged?
- On what grounds would you have a case against God?
- What might God have against you? Would it hold up in court?
- How do justice and mercy come into play in your case?
- Why is religion so inadequate?
- What does the Lord expect from those who are His? How does that tie into the religious aspects of their faith?
- What does it mean to do right? To love mercy? To walk humbly with God?

### Influential:

- What can you do this week to incorporate these three things in your interpersonal relationship with others? With God?
